

## DLTS signs contract with Saab Aerosystems

### **DLTS (Danish Learning & Training Systems), subsidiary of CORENA, signs training and simulation contract with Saab Aerosystems related to Gripen Next Generation.**

CORENA announce today that their subsidiary, DLTS, has signed an important contract with Saab Aerosystems related to providing 3D conversion tools, computer based training and development of simulation systems. The contract is placed with DLTS ApS, a CORENA and Cadpeople joint venture.

The main elements of the contract encompass 3 projects related to development of simulator systems, computer based training of mechanics, and systems integration between the product data models of the Gripen fighter aircraft, with the purpose of supporting Gripen in international operations.

The agreement is the first in a row of several orders to come. A further development of the maintenance and support concepts will be realized provided that Danish defense selects Gripen as their future fighter aircraft.

“We experience an increasing interest for Gripen as the technologically and economically best platform for future fighter aircraft for Denmark. It is therefore important for us to find competent industry partners in Denmark that can contribute to the further development of Gripen through its lifecycle. Our collaboration with CORENA, DLTS and Cadpeople are examples of a good industrial team, which will enrich the Gripen fighter aircraft in the future”, says Kjell Möller, Senior Vice President, Saab Industrial Cooperation.

“For CORENA, Cadpeople and DLTS, this order implies that we are able to expand our product portfolio to include a significantly larger footprint of the ILS (Integrated Logistics Support) domain. Furthermore we are able to develop simulation, training and product support systems, that will be very competitive in the global market, where systems availability is expected to be 100%. Additionally our collaboration with Saab will result in increased access to a global network within the defense industry”, says Keld Jellesen, Managing Director, DLTS and Corena Danmark A/S.
